Yarmouth Market Policy for Community Tables

The Yarmouth Market will provide local registered non-profit and charitable organizations an opportunity to raise funds in support of their initiatives during the market season. All organizations, non-profit groups and their representatives who wish to participate will submit an application for specific date(s), along with a formal signed letter on letterhead (or copy of) of the organization's/non-profit's initiatives or fundraising purposes. Table space will be granted when available.

The Market Manager and/or Board of Directors will have the right to schedule such groups on a rotational basis.

All products to be sold must first be approved by the Market Manager or Market Board of Directors and can not compete with items already sold by our vendors at the market. We do welcome raffles, 50/50 draws, gift certificates, membership drives and donation jars. The table may also be used to promote/educate and distribute informational material to the public.

Distribution and sale of items of any political, religious, pornographic or offensive nature are prohibited.

All organizations, non-profit groups and their representatives must adhere to the same rules as Market Vendors. Table set up must be completed at least 15 minutes prior to Market opening and must remain open for the entire duration of the Market. Cars must be parked at the Yarmouth Visitors Center. Proper signage of Organization/Non-profit's name and purpose must be displayed on the table.

Raffles sales are permitted on the conditions that a valid license issued by the NS Lottery Commission (or copy), the raffle prize (or photograph of the prize), the purpose of the raffle and raffle times and dates are displayed on the table.
